Dear 9th Grade Student and Parent:

Ninth Grade Orientation will be held at Jones College Prep, 606 South State Street, on Monday, August 21st and Tuesday, August 22nd, from 9:00 a.m. until 1:00 each day. Attendance is mandatory for students on both days. A parent/guardian should accompany the student on the first day only, Monday, August 21st.

The opening session will be held in our auditorium. It will begin with a presentation of the highly acclaimed *Making High School Count*, a program which will be presented nationwide to over 1,000,000 entering high school students this summer and fall. Orientation activities are planned to help the student and family make an easy transition to high school. Highlights of the two days include an introduction to our administrative and leadership team and information regarding the fundamentals of operating procedures at Jones College Prep.

Students, please note the label with your Name, Home Court Number, and Room Assignment at the bottom of this page. This is your Home Court and room for the two days of orientation. Parents, enclosed is a card with your child’s name and Home Court number. On August 21st, you will follow a schedule according to the Home Court for your child. Parents will need a pen or pencil.

Students must return Forms 3, 4, 5, 6, 10, 11, 12, and 13 during orientation to receive their program. School fees must be paid. Please note the following:

- Bring pen and pencils to orientation.
- Dress in neat attire appropriate for school – ID photos will be taken on Monday; August 21st. Yearbook photos will be taken on Tuesday, August 22nd.
- Return **completed** medical and dental forms.
- Pay activity fee (\$165.00), calculator (\$100.00), and retreat fee (\$30.00). Check or money order is the preferred method of payment. It should be made payable to Jones College Prep.
- Bring \$5.00 (cash) for a CTA pass.

Orientation acts as the bridge between elementary and high school. Activities are designed to help you feel comfortable beginning this new chapter in your life. You should be assured that the faculty and staff of Jones College Prep are committed to providing you a challenging college preparatory curriculum and opportunities for personal and academic enrichment.
